Physical description: House built in brick with a galvanised iron roof and bullnose verandah. The chimneys are face brick with

rendered mouldings. Decorated with rendered quoins in sandstone courses. The gables are decorated with carved timber infills and the finial appears to have been removed. The windows are double hung with two panes per sash to the gable. Lable moulds decorate the windows on the projecting gable end.

The verandah has been enclosed to the south.

The projecting gable may have been added at a later date and the earlier house form which is visible is a simple vernacular Georgian cottage. Further investigation is required to assess the fabric in detail.

There are a number of outbuildings located to the north of the house and access to these was not obtained. These require further investigation.


