

CHANGES TO DUNGOG SHIRE COUNCIL'S RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

Please see below for information regarding the status of council's Recreational Facilities, as of Monday 20 September 2021:

Amenities

- Dungog Shire Public Toilets have now re-opened; however, the following facilities will have time restrictions of 7.30am to 4.30pm: Vacy Park, Orana Park Gresford, and Clarence Town School of Arts.
- Dungog Shire BBQs will be re-opened as quickly as possible, but not prior to Wednesday 22 September 2021.

Parks and Open Spaces

- All parks, including outdoor exercise equipment, playgrounds and skateparks, remain open across Dungog Shire.

Please be aware that playground equipment is not being cleaned or disinfected.

- Clarence Town Tennis Courts are currently open for social use.

Sporting Facilities

- All Sporting Facilities will re-open at the discretion of the respective management committees.

Recreational Vehicle (RV) Dump Points

- Council operated RV Dump Points at Dungog Showground and Clarence Town Lions Park remain open.

Community Halls

- Due to school holidays, our local Community Halls will reopen Week One of Term 4.

Swimming Facilities

- Dungog Swimming Pool and Clarence Town Pool are set to reopen to casual visitors on Friday 1 October 2021.

We're now working through all the necessary details with our pool operators, including the COVID-Safe protocols that will apply as per the NSW Health guidelines, which are set to be released shortly.
