Please place your items out the SUNDAY BEFORE.

Waste collected should not exceed two cubic metres (more than 1 standard 7' x 4' level box trailer)



Bulky items must be of manageable size for two people to lift.

Please place waste into (2) separate piles:

- Scrap Metal and Whitegoods
 - General Bulky Waste

All items are to be placed neatly next to the edge of the kerb (and not blocking the footpath).

LOOSE ITEMS must be tied securely with rope or string (not wire), into bundles or contained in sturdy boxes.

- METALS including empty whitegoods with DOORS REMOVED, car batteries, disassembled bed frames.

- **BULKY HOUSEHOLD WASTE** larger items such as unrepairable furniture, and broken old floor coverings, glass WRAPPED IN NEWSPAPER.



- Above waste types stacked in SEPARATE PILES
- All waste stacked neatly next to the kerb not on the footpath, road or private property

FURTHER NOTES

- Loose items must be bundled or contained
- Wire must be rolled and tied securely
- Fencing in large quantities and wire not rolled and tied securely will not be accepted
- Hot water systems larger than 260 litres will not be accepted

Unacceptable Items!

- GARDEN ORGANICS (i.e. green waste)
- **★** SMALL ITEMS If it can go in your red lidded bin for normal collection, don't put it out.
- UNREASONABLY HEAVY OR BULKY OBJECTS If two people can't lift it, don't put it out.
- **★** BAGGED ITEMS If the waste is not visible, don't put it out.
- **X** LIQUIDS
- HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS OR MATERIALS including barbed wire and asbestos
- **★** FOODSTUFFS
- COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL **WASTE / BUILDING MATERIALS**
- X TYRES & MOTOR CAR BODIES
- **EARTH, STONE, BRICKS OR RUBBLE**
- **MORE THAN 2 CUBIC METRES PER HOUSEHOLD** (i.e. the size of a standard ute tray)
