

## CHANGES TO DUNGOG SHIRE COUNCIL'S RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

Please see below information regarding the status of recreational facilities until further notice.

These restrictions are in accordance with the Public Health Orders for local government areas where the stay at home rules apply, effective Thursday 5 August 2021.

### Amenities

- All Shire public toilets will have restricted access;  
Dungog – Disabled Toilet James Theatre, Brown Street adjacent to Council Administration Building and Lioness Park Dungog remain open, Bruen Park and Bennett Park Closed  
Paterson – John Tucker Park open  
The following Amenities will be open 7.30am to 4.30pm –Vacy Park, Orana Park Gresford and Clarence Town School of Arts
- All Shire public BBQ facilities have been disabled.

Re- Open dates are yet to be determined. Future operation will be in line with NSW Government restrictions as prescribed in the Public Health Orders.

### Parks and Open Spaces

- All parks, including outdoor exercise equipment, playgrounds and skateparks, remain open across the Dungog LGA. Public toilets across the LGA have been restricted and public BBQ's have been disabled.
- Tennis Courts have restricted access as prescribed in the Public Health Orders. No competitive play including social competitions are permissible under the current stay at home orders.

**Playground equipment is not being cleaned or sanitised.**

### Sporting Facilities

- All sporting facilities are closed during stay at home orders commencing 5pm Thursday 5 August 2021. Shire Sporting clubs have been advised.

Re- open dates are yet to be determined. Future operations will be in line with NSW Government restrictions as prescribed in the Public Health Order.

### Recreational Vehicle (RV) Dump Points

- Council operated RV Dump Points at Dungog Showground and Clarence Town Lions Park remain open.

## Community Halls

- Community halls are closed during stay at home orders from 5pm Thursday 5 August 2021. Hall management committees and hirers have been advised.

Re-open dates are yet to be determined. Future operations will be in line with NSW Government restrictions as prescribed in the Public Health Orders.

## Swimming Facilities

- Council's outdoor seasonal pools at Dungog and Clarence Town are currently closed for the winter and will re-open in October.

Future operations will be in line with NSW Government restrictions as prescribed in the Public Health Order.

## Camping and Caravan Park

- Dungog Shire Council operated Camping and Williams River Caravan Park will be closed from 5pm Thursday 5 August 2021 in line with NSW Government restrictions as prescribed in the Public Health Orders.

Caravan Parks must close **except** for permanent residents or other people who have no other place of permanent residence. Stay at home directions must be complied with, by all residents who have an exemption to remain within the park.
